Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Ulaanbaatar, the Mongolian capital, for a city tour and much needed rest after our flight. Our accommodation for the evening is one of the many Western hotels in the city.

Day 2: We drive by Jeep to Karakorum region of Ovorkhangai province and have our first experience staying at one of the many yurt camps the dot the countryside.

Day 3: We visit the Erdenee Zuu Monastery which is oldest in Mongolia. We end the day with an optional soak in the hot water springs of the Orkhon Valley.

Day 4 & 5: Here we start our trek through Central Mongolia with one day spent with nomadic family.

Day 6: We say goodbye to our host family and drive to Bag Gazarlin Chuluu

Day 7 & 8: We spend two days trekking through the Gobi Desert with a surprise to see that it is not the sand dune wasteland that we might think. One night is spent in a yurt camp and one night with another family.

Day 9 & 10: Drive back to Ulaanbaatar and depart on day 10
